Basic Mortuary Technician Short Course

INTRODUCTION

The MUHAS Anatomy Department in collaboration with Muhimbili National Hospital, Mortuary Department is pleased to announce short course on Basic Mortuary Technician short course from 2- 27 October 2017.

Aim

The aim of the course is to empower mortuary workers with the necessary skills and ethics which are lacking in most mortuaries in the country.

Course Objectives

By the end of the training the participants should be able to:

1. Safely use and dispose embalming chemicals and reagents
2. Apply basic anatomy and physiology in body embalming and management
3. Properly embalm bodies of different ages, injury and decomposition status
4. Use PPE, protect environment and people
5. Explain the common disease that can be contracted in the mortuary and their risks
6. Keep ethical code and morals for the dead

Expected Competencies

1. Properly embalm bodies of different ages, injury and decomposition status
2. Ethically and morally hand the dead in manner that respect professional and cultural standards

Target groups

The course attracts participants from both public and private health facility working in mortuaries or those anticipating to.

Structure of the course

- Basic Anatomy and Physiology 12 hrs
- Embalming and Embalming Chemicals 18 hrs
- Mortuary diseases, risks, hazards and ethics 12 hrs
- Mortuary practicals 48 hrs

Mode of Instruction

Interactive lectures, problem based learning actual practice will be used

Course Instructors

Lectures from Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences (MUHAS), Anatomy Department and mortuary Staff of Muhimbili National hospital.

Course Duration

The course will be run for four weeks

Course Fees

Each participants will be required to pay a total of Tsh. 560,000/= for Tuition Fee and overhead administrative costs
