**FINAL MINISTERIAL REPORT AS REPORT AS PER ACTION PLAN**

The Ministry of Sports and Social Affairs had a number of plans and goals to be accomplished during our term of leadership in the outgoing MUHASSO government.

This final ministerial report shows tasks which have successfully been implemented, some tasks which we have failed to accomplish some challenges we have encountered during our leadership and lastly suggestions to the coming ministry of Sports.

**A: ACHIEVEMENTS.**

- 1. Ministry of sports and social affairs in collaboration with the office of Prime Minister managed to organize the Mbuzi Cup tournaments, which began from 08<sup>th</sup> June 2009 to 20<sup>th</sup> June 2009. The tournaments comprised of three games namely, football, basketball and volleyball.**
- 2. The Ministry organized the Muhimbili Zain Challenge competition. Four winners at University level were obtained and they represented the University to Tanzania Zain Challenge competition which took place at Blue Pearl – Ubungo Plaza.**

- 3. Preparation and organizing the Orientation sports day and social evening event for the first years at the end of their orientation week. The event took place on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2009 at MUHAS campus.**
- 4. The Ministry requested the Management through the office of Directorate of Planning and Development (DPD) to maintain the football and volleyball grounds at MUHAS campus. Also requested to build a basketball court at Chole Campus. Management has promised to build the basketball ground at Chole Road hostels.**
- 5. Ministry has managed to purchase 5 sets of football jerseys, enough volleyballs, a new volleyball net, new basketballs, and new sacks, though one pair of goalkeeper's jersey is missing for each set. There was a scarcity of jerseys and by so doing; at least the problem has been taken care of.**
- 6. On HIV and AIDS day, the Ministry in collaboration with Tanzania Health Promotion Initiative (THPI) organized a charity football match between MUHAS and IFM which took place at Muhas grounds. The MUHAS team won the match and awarded with a trophy. Then all players were invited to Karimjee where various matters on HIV/AIDS and YOUTH were discussed.**
- 7. The installation of DsTV at Chole road hostels was directly implemented largely by the office of the President and the Ministry of ICT. But since it was in our action plan we thank the office of the President and ICT for accomplishing that task.**
- 7. The Ministry organized the Fresher's ball for welcoming our dear brothers and sisters-first years 2009/2010 which was successful done. The event took place on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2009 at Msasani Beach.**

8. **Organization of Sports Bonanza which was held on 27<sup>th</sup> February 2010, It included a lot of games like football, basketball, volleyball, various race, tug of war etc, also all football matches were monitored by a professional referee.**

#### **B: CHALLENGES.**

1. **Requests sent to the University Management face a very minimal attention and as a result the delay of the response and delay or even failure to implement some activities despite of the reminders posed to the offices concerned. That is to say there is poor cooperation from the university management. E.g. Request for maintaining the play grounds and building a new one at Chole is sent to the management for so long but the response is yet not feasible.**
2. **Lack of fund to implement various activities and buy sports gears. Currently, despite of buying new football jerseys, the situation of sports item in other teams is bad; there are no jerseys for basketball team, volleyball team, and netball team.**
3. **The Ministry, during the last Mbuji cup tournament faced some problems as the result of indecisions. The problems which led to resolution of the football competition during that tournament. It is a challenge but is also a setback as is mostly caused by lack of enough funds to hire professional referees.**
4. **There is, still a little participation from female society at the university in different social activities and events organized by the Ministry and other stakeholders.**
5. **There is poor co-operation from other Non-MUHASSO student's leadership that is MUNUSO and IHASSO this is by poor**

**contribution of even few sports items like balls on competitions or normal everyday exercises every sports item is being purchased by MUHASSO.**

- 6. The issue of condolence ,currently there is poor participation of students in case one fellow has lost the close member of the family, also the role of Muhas management to make sure the student is assisted economically in case he/she encounter such a problem.**

#### **D.PENDING TASKS**

- 1. The Ministry requested for an area to be used as a volleyball court at Chole hostel but we were told to wait because Management had a plan to build a Basketball court, so we should wait for an area to be allocated.**
- 2. The Muhas Management promised to buy new jerseys for University teams of Basketball, Football, Volleyball and Netball centrally according to the availability of funds on this year.**

#### **E.FAILURES**

- 1. In our Action plan, We aimed at improving the girls participation in social and Sports activities but we have failed to convince our girls to participate in various Sports and Social activities.**
- 2.Failure to consult various sponsors like companies and banks to assist in buying various Sports gears and Sponsor local and inter-universities competitions.**

#### **F.SUGESSTION TO THE COMING GOVERNMENT**

- 1. To make sure grounds are properly conserved and not being used as car parking.**
- 2. Work closely with other non-MUHASSO (MUNUSO and IHASSO) organization to improve the Sports and Social Activities at the University.**

**3. Close follow-up to make sure the promised sports gears are bought and Chole gets a basketball and volleyball court.**

**The Ministry of Sports and Social Affairs is honored to appreciate and thanks for the co operation from the higher offices of MUHASSO and all Ministries and other government organs in general.**

**Lastly, we sincerely thank the office of the President, office of the Prime Minister for good help, constructive directives and on my own behalf I feel honored for being part of this government.**
