Sawe is an emergency physician, faculty and a researcher in the only full capacity public emergency department, at the Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences (MUHAS) in Dar es Salaam, in Tanzania. He is also an adjunct Assistant professor of Emergency Medicine at Carolinas Health Care system, in Charlotte USA.</p> <p>Dr. Sawe hold a the Masters of Medicine in Emergency Medicine, and Master of Business Administration from MUHAS and Mzumbe University, Tanzania respectively. He completed National Institutes of Health (NIH) mentored research fellowship in 2015, and He is currently pursuing PhD with University of Cape Town, South Africa.</p> <p>He has 8 years experience in Emergency Care, Emergency medical system, curriculum development and implementation, and setting up emergency care research infrastructure in Low Income countries.</p> <p>He has executed a number of research documenting the regional burden of emergency disease, testing different interventions to improve care and outcomes in patients seen in emergency units in Tanzania and other Sub-Saharan African countries. He has disseminated his work in 40 peer reviewed journals, and over 40 international scientific conferences. His work in research was recognised with the best research award at the Society for Emergency Medicine (SAEM) in 2013, Atlanta USA, and also in Outstanding Contribution to Global</p>

Emergency Medicine Research award, presented by the SAEM's Global Emergency Medicine Academy, in 2018.

Dr. Sawe has worked with World Health Organisation Department for the Management of NCDs, Disability, Violence and Injury Prevention in Geneva, and World Bank in Tanzania as a consultant on a number of programs in emergency systems for low income countries. He is currently working with the Ministry of Health of Tanzania to establish the first formal pre-hospital system (EMS) in Tanzania.

In research and advocacy, Dr. Sawe is an associate editor for both Tanzania Medical Journal, and African Journal of Emergency Medicine, serves as president of the Emergency Medicine Association of Tanzania, the national professional association charged with disseminating emergency care in Tanzania, and board member of the African Federation for Emergency Medicine.
