### B: REGULATIONS FOR PAYMENTS

- (1) You can pay the whole fees or half of the fees at the beginning of the first term and the remaining fees can be paid at the beginning of the second term of studies. (Any student who fails to pay the cost sharing money within a month after start of Academic year will be deregistered). As a deregistered student, you will be needed to re-apply afresh if you want to be our student in future.
- (2) Ensure that you obtain an official receipt for payments made to the Centre/School.
- (3) Non-Tanzanians students can pay Tanzanian money equivalent to the forex amount he/she is supposed to pay.
- (4) When at the University you should obey the lawful instructions of all the leaders in the training institution of the University and the country.
- (5) You have to make arrangements of your own traveling expenses to and from the University for all the years of studies.
- (6) Students are expected to have adequate pocket money for essential expenses.
- (7) All in-service foreign and private students are advised to come with/use their Health Insurance cards for treatment when they are at the Institute.
- (8) Students admitted at Tanga, Mpwapwa and KCMC Campuses should pay their tuition fee to their respective schools/ campuses

**C: OTHER REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Beddings:
2. Sportswear - these are optional. You may come with some for the sports of your interest.
3. At least two pairs of shoes.
4. A bath towel or two.
5. Four pass-port size photographs (black and white).
6. Stationery (pens, pencils, note books, etc).
7. Table plate, bowl, mug, spoons, (For Tanga School of Hygiene).
8. At least 2 Clinical coats for all courses except nursing. Nursing student are required to come with TShs. 100,000/- as uniform fee.

Please note that the climate in Dar es Salaam and Tanga is warm/hot and humid, Moshi is wet and cold in April to July, and Mpwapwa enjoys typical tropical weather. You are advised to bring extra wear in view of the above.

**D:** On arrival at the University, you should report to the Warden, of the Allied Health Sciences Hostel near the Undergraduate Hostel and the Taxi/Bus Park at Muhimbili.

**You should show this letter to the Warden of the Hostel.**

**N.B:** If you do not wish to stay in halls of residence you may inform your Director, as residing in Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences Hostels is for convenience but not compulsory.

**E:** For your registration you should arrange to visit the Director, Institute of Allied Health Sciences Offices from **29<sup>th</sup> October 2018 up to 9<sup>th</sup> November 2018** with this letter, your original education profile certificates, medical certificates and four pass-port size photographs (black and white).

**F:** Ensure that you inform your sponsor about this offer and that you come with the required fees or the same is paid to the Institute or respective School in advance.

Please note that the deadline for admission and registration is **strictly on 9<sup>th</sup> November 2018**. You will not be admitted nor registered if you are not in the School by that date.
