He holds an MPharm degree from Pyatigorsk Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences in Russia, MSc in Pharmaceutical and Medical Research at Vrije University of Brussels, and PhD in Clinical Pharmacology from the University of Dar es Salaam in Collaboration with Karolinska Institute in Sweden. He Joined MUHAS while it was still called Faculty of Medicine in 1992 and has supervised 12 students in Hospital and Mpharm clinical Pharmacy and 3 in MSc clinical Pharmacology. He has also supervised 5 PhD students in clinical Pharmacology. Prof Minzi conducts short courses in Clinical Pharmacokinetics and Pharmacovigilance targeting mainly trainees from academia, research, regulatory and other institutions. He department recently developed a short course in bioanalytics: HPLC method development and validation and recently developed He now supervises 3 Master degree students and 3 PhDs. He has disseminated his findings in local and international research forums and has more than 45 publications in peer reviewed journals. He now heads Bioanalytical laboratory at MUHAS</p> |
