Personal statement	 <p>Andrea Barnabas Pembe is a Professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences (MUHAS), Dar es Salaam, Tanzania. He holds a Doctor of Medicine and Master of Medicine degrees from the University of Dar es Salaam and a PhD from Uppsala University in Medicine Sciences based in reproductive, maternal and newborn health. Before joining MUHAS in the year 2002, he worked at Sekou Toure Regional Hospital, Mwanza Tanzania as a Medical Officer for 3 years and later as an Obstetrician and Gynaecologist for one year. Andrea teaches obstetrics and gynaecology to undergraduate and postgraduate students and has supervised more than 20 Master students and one PhD student in the areas of obstetrics, gynaecology, reproductive health, public health and health systems. Andrea is involved in training of service providers on reproductive health including comprehensive post abortion care, family planning methods, assisted vaginal deliveries, management of postpartum haemorrhage, monitoring of labour and management of severe pre-eclampsia and eclampsia. He has participated in developing guidelines on reproductive and newborn health under the Ministry of Health, Community Development, Gender, elders and Children. The guidelines include diagnosis and treatment of malaria, basic and comprehensive emergency obstetric and neonatal care, emergency obstetric job aid, post abortion care and family planning. He has conducted researches in his area of focus and has a number of collaborators including Uppsala University and Karolinska Institute, Sweden; Leiden University Medical Centre, Netherland; Bergen University and Norwegian University of Science and Technology, Norway and University of Illinois at Chicago</p>

	and Harvard University, US. He has disseminated his findings in local and international research forums and has more than 40 publications in peer reviewed journals.
