THE INNOVATION AND ENTERPRENUERSHIP IN HEALTH CARE COURSE

The Directorate of Research and Publication together with the network of institutions in the public and private sectors is organizing an Innovation and Entrepreneurship in health care course aiming to initiate, import, modify and diffuse new technologies to address health care challenges. Participants will be exposed to useful tools which will motivate them to explore, protect, disseminate and commercialize innovations and development into business and services.

Course Dates: 28-30th June, 2021

Aims and content: This course aims to enable participants to assess health challenges, identify opportunities, evaluate potential innovative solutions and apply entrepreneurial skills in proposing solutions as means of improving health and health care delivery

Expected course outcomes:

At the end of the course, participants are expected to be able to

1. Describe the key concepts of entrepreneurship, innovation and intellectual assets
2. Understand procedures, drivers and barrier for Innovation
3. Understand rules, guideline, regulations and policies that govern Innovation
4. Evaluate cultural, ethical and policies relevant in human health entrepreneurship.
5. Demonstrate interpersonal and leadership skills in networks.
6. Critically evaluate potential and existing solutions to problems in human health from an entrepreneurial and innovative perspective.

Who can attend: Academicians, Researchers and project managers having at least Bachelor degree, and Students enrolled in Higher learning Institution
