### SHORT COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT ADVANCED QUALITATIVE RESEARCH COURSE



#### Course Description

The use of qualitative research in health care enables researchers to answer questions that may not be easily answered by quantitative methods. However, for qualitative research to have scientific merit researchers need to be able to design advanced qualitative studies, conduct rigorous analysis of qualitative data, appraise and critic qualitative studies.

#### Course Content and Aim

This course aims to provide hands-on, in-depth and advanced training for specific methodologies of qualitative data collection, analytic techniques and research design issues. The participants will be able to analyze and deal with complex issues associated with qualitative research.

#### General Course Information

**Who can attend:** PhD students, Master's students, academicians, or anyone with a bachelor degree in a health-related field, who has a basic knowledge in qualitative research and they are planning to conduct a qualitative study. For an effective training, only 30 participants will be accepted.

**Location:** MUHAS at CHPE building.

**Fees:** Tsh 300,000/= for Non-MUHAS Tanzanians and \$ 500 for Non-Tanzanian or those residing outside the country. The fee should be paid through control numbers which will be provided after the notification of acceptance.

**CPD credits:** Equivalent to 30 CPD units

**Method of Instructions:** Lectures, group presentations/discussions, practical group work and case studies.

#### Scope

The duration of the course corresponds to five (5) days full-time study, comprising of Lectures, group presentations/discussions, practical group work, case studies and concluding with an individual evaluation.

#### Participant expected outcome

At the end of this course, participants are expected to be able to:

1. Demonstrate application of appropriate qualitative research approaches in line with research problem at hand
2. Explain ethical issues in qualitative research
3. Demonstrate mastery of grounded theory in qualitative data analysis
4. Use NViVO computer software for managing qualitative data
5. Critique qualitative research works
