## SHORT COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT GRANT WRITING COURSE



### Course Description

This short course is intended to equip scientists, students and grant managers with knowledge and skills on identifying, applying and managing research grants. It will be facilitated by grant writing experienced scientists at MUHAS and other institutions.

### Course Content and Aim

Pre-grant proposal preparation, the role of OSP in grant proposal preparation and submission, Do's and Don'ts of grant proposal writing, budgeting, and requirements of funders and reviewers of the grant applications.

### General Course Information

**Who can attend:** MUHAS faculty, students, researchers, Non-governmental and Governmental Organizations grant managers, and other relevant professionals with at least a bachelor/equivalent level education. The applicants must demonstrate the need for the course by submitting a grant application at any stage of development or reviewers' comments that need to be addressed or an abstract for a grant application. For an effective training, only 30 participants will be accepted

**Location:** MUHAS at CHPE building.

**Fees:** Tsh 200,000/= for Non-MUHAS affiliated Tanzanians and \$100 for Non-Tanzanian or those residing outside the country. The fee should be paid through control numbers which will be provided after the notification of acceptance. The course fee covers; Tuition fee, course materials and certificate.

**CPD credits:** 4CEPD credit point certificates after attaining a minimum requirement of the course by full participation to at least 85% of all sessions.

**Method of Instructions:** Interactive lectures, group work, practical and problem-based learning techniques.

### Application Requirements

1. All applicants must send an application letter, a 2-page CV, and the grant proposal at any developmental stage. A recommendation letter from the heads of units where students are attached to will be required for all postgraduate students whereas the rest of applicants must indicate in their application letters an individual or organization who will pay for the course fees.

### Participant expected outcome

At the end of this course, participants are expected to be able to; identify funding opportunities and appropriate collaborators, understand and response to the application requirements which are appropriate to the funder (budget, proposal et).
