Bootcamp Description and Aim

Innovation is identified as one of the University's key principles in par with teaching research and consultancy. For this reason, Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences through the Directorate of Research and Publications will conduct a rigorous, immersive, collaborative, action-oriented learning Innovation bootcamp. The purpose of the innovation boot camp is to explore basic principles of and to promote Innovation at the University. Furthermore, the bootcamp will help innovators understand the principles of innovation: problem discovery and ideation, value creation, and more. Over the course of one week, students will learn and work with each other and a team of experts to build and deliver value through innovation. They will also receive hands on coaching by experienced innovators and entrepreneurs.

Content of the bootcamp

To attain the objectives of this short course, the following topics will be covered; Design thinking, business models, prototyping, intellectual property and pitching.

Faculty and students at any level may attend. As this is a hands-on training, applicants must already have an innovation project idea at any level from ideation to a working project. To ensure quality training, a maximum of 20 innovation projects will be selected. Each project may have a maximum of four team members.
